**Kerry Film Festival** will present a specialist programme of films that commemorates 1916 working with local and national institutions and filmmakers. The programme will provide opportunities for local filmmakers and audiences to explore the historic and contemporary influences and consequences of 1916.

Programme elements includes:

- (1) Short film open submission competition, an opportunity for local filmmakers to engage with this subject either through factual or narrative film genres
- (2) Working with the IFI National Archive to present a series of films that depicts the region at that time.
- (3) Talks on filmmaking from the era and the development of the medium since that time, looking at the impact and consequences of events in 1916 on how Ireland was depicted on screen, the development of an Irish visual identity, etc.
